Sage Day Enrichment Continues During Extended School Year

New Jersey — June. 27, 2016 — This year marks the 20th year that Sage Day is running their extended school year program for existing and new students. This five week program runs from June 27- July 29 for all four Sage Day locations from 9:00-12:00 p.m.

Director of School Operations, Christopher Leonard said some of the benefits of participating in the extended school year include: prevention of regression through continuous access to therapeutic and academic support, ease of transition for students who are returning to school after extended time away from school or for students who are entering high school for the first time.

Each principal will be leading the program at each location. Sage Day Rochelle Park Principal, Robert Friedland, said they begin the day as a group watching the morning news. From there, the students break off into classes and cycle through math and literacy instruction, incorporating problem-based activities that may revolve around topical events. The last period of the day the students either attend group therapy or electives.

Sage Day Boonton Principal, Mary Rose Scalo, said, “The primary goal of the extended school year program is to help students maintain the gains they have made since their enrollment in Sage Day. These gains generally fall into three categories: improved and consistent attendance, meeting or exceeding academic expectations, and meaningful engagement in therapy sessions.”
